- ⑧ The supervisor's Mam requested the teachers to introduce themselves to the parents, mentioning the subjects they teach.


⑨ Miss sheetal vartak encouraged the parents and students to be supportive and allow their wards to be a part of the college comp, which is a part of their physical and mental growth.


- The supervisor's mam also stimulate and informed about PTA and requested parents to co-operate college and teachers for their

→ Following points were discussed by the supervisor Madam in the meeting related to 2nd half of the academic year [Sem II] :-



→ Following points were discussed by the supervisor madam in the meeting related to 2nd half of the exams for T.Y.B.com (sem VI)



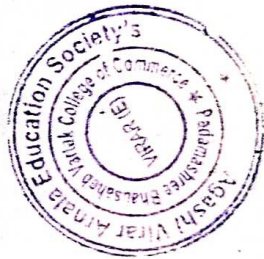

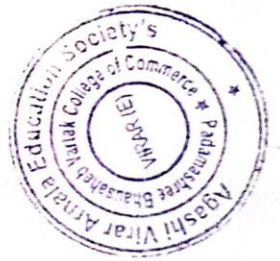
