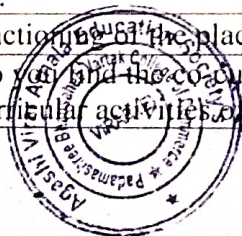

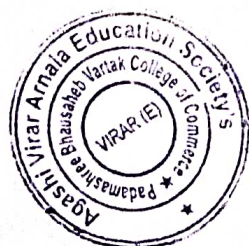

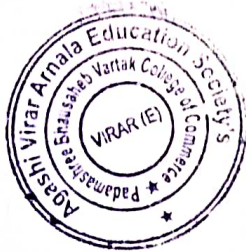

According to the analysis, following major points have been noticed:

1. Most of the teachers are good at illustration of concepts and lecture delivery. However, students expect their teachers to be more technology oriented with special reference to the use of ICT tools in teaching-learning process.
2. In case of library facilities, it was observed that students are happy with availability of range of books.
3. Regarding Gymkhana facilities, it is suggested that Gymkhana infrastructure needs to be enhanced with more variety of sports.
4. Students have expressed satisfaction over computer laboratory facilities but have mentioned that they need more computers to do individual practice.
5. Regarding canteen facilities- Students suggested to start the canteen again. (As canteen was shut due to COVID-19 pandemic).
6. The teachers asked for computers in the staffroom for their working.
7. The teachers advised to conduct extra lectures for weak and brilliant students separately.
8. In order to make the students to undertake research activity, teachers advised to conduct workshop on how to conduct the research.
9. Parents demanded regular update of their student's attendance
